Charles Matton was born in Paris in 1931 where he lived until his death in 2008. He was a multidisciplinary artist: painter, sculptor, designer, writer, photographer, videographer, as well as a film writer and director. His work has been exhibited worldwide at venues such as *Palais de Tokyo*, Paris; *AVA Gallery*, London; *Michael Haas Gallery*, Berlin; *Museum of Arts and Design*, New York; *Städtische Museen*, Germany; *CAFA Art Museum*, Beijing, China; and *Forum Gallery*, New York and Los Angeles. His work can be found in public collections including the *National Museum of Modern Art*, Kyoto and Tokyo, Japan; *Maison Européenne de la Photographie*, Paris; a permanent installation at the *Bibliothèque Nationale de France*, Paris; and many private collections, including the *Me Collection*, Berlin.
